STEP 5: UNDERSTANDING THE SELECTION PROCESS

The Josie Dugue' Lain Foundation strives to inspire students in our community to pursue academic achievement and growth in STEM disciplines. The scholarships will be awarded to well-rounded students who are academically successful and involved in extra-curricular activities / volunteer work.

PURPOSE: To provide a scholarship to one (1) Louisiana high school graduating senior interested in or intending to pursue a STEM degree at Southern University A&M College.

AWARD COMPONENT: One (1) \$1,000 scholarship paid over two semesters (\$500 on/by August 3, 2018 and \$500 on/by January 4, 2019) selected by the Josie Dugue' Lain Foundation Scholarship Committee.

CRITERIA:

- Applicant must be a Louisiana resident.
- Applicant must be a graduating high school senior in the year of the award.
- Applicant must have demonstrated financial need as determined by the Office of Student Financial Aid.
- Applicant must be a full-time freshman in the Southern University System in the coming academic year with an interest or intent to pursue a STEM degree.

APPLICATION PROCESS: (APPLICANT MUST SUBMIT)

- Completed application form.
- Essay addressed to the Scholarship Committee.
- Two (2) letters of recommendation.
- Complete high school transcript with cumulative GPA and class standing/rank.
